
### **Report of the Sports Meet (Summer) - 2022 held w.e.f. 31<sup>st</sup> May to 3<sup>rd</sup> June'2022**

The Annual Sports Meet (Summer)-2022 was inaugurated in the Fatikroy HS School playground with a brief inaugural session. The session was started at 10-30 am and was attended by Dr. Subrata Sharma, Principal in Charge, Dr. Chandan Debnath,

IQAC Coordinator, and Dr. Zakir Hussain, the convenor Sports Committee of Ambedkar College. In their short speeches, the guests emphasised the importance of games and sports.

Dr. Subrata Sharma, in his speech, sought cooperation from all the teachers, students



and others present in the ground. He also appreciated the efforts of the sports committee and students for organising this colourful event. Dr. Sharma also wished success of

the Sports Meet-2022.

The first two days were allotted for outdoor games and six nos. of Physical Instructors



were deputed by the District Youth and Sports Authority, Unakoti District, for smooth organization of the programme. The first-day competition was started with 100 metre sprint (Boys) followed by 100 metre Sprint (Girls), 200 metre run (Boys & Girls), 400 metre run (Boys & Girls), 4×100 metre Relay race (Boys & Girls) etc. Then other items like High-jump, Long-jump, Shot-Put, Jabaline Throw etc. were organized one after another. The day-long programmes were witnessed by the teachers and students and enjoyed by the participants. Both Boys & Girls equally participated in the various items, and the Physical Instructors smoothly conducted day-long programme with the active support of teachers & students. The 1<sup>st</sup> Day programme was ended at 5-30 pm.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Day programme was started at 10-00 am on the 1<sup>st</sup> June in the same Venue. The day's programme began with Kabaddi Competition among the various semesters. The Boys & Girls Kabaddi teams participated in the event. After the Kabaddi, the Volleyball competition was started where only the Boys team participated. Finally, in the evening, the Football competition
