

The Department of Sanskrit, Ambedkar College, is pleased to announce to introduce a Non-formal Sanskrit Certificate/Diploma Course, under the mantle of Central Sanskrit University (Formerly Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi, Deemed to be University accredited by NAAC with 'A' Grade), under the M. H. R. D.,Govt. of India.

Non-Formal Sanskrit Education: Sanskrit language is the unparalleled treasure of Indian wisdom and culture. Theresources preserved in this language are vast and manifold. A Large number of Indians desires to learn Sanskrit in order to preserve and project original Indianness. It is essential to fulfill their desire by providing the knowledge of Sanskrit language through the simplest possible method and to make them aware of the knowledge well treasured in Sanskrit. In order to execute this ideal and essential object by providing the opportunity and facility tothose who are desirous to learn Sanskrit, Central Sanskrit University has started Non-FormalSanskrit Education.

<u>Central Sanskrit University</u>: A Deemed University under the Ministry of HumanResource Development, Govt. of India and it is only one and unique to be multi-campusdeemed University. It has 12 Campuses in 12 States in India, 22 Adarsha Sanskrit Collegesand 04 Research Institutes. Since its establishment (15th October, 1970) the Sansthan isdevoted for the all-inclusive development of Sanskrit in all India level by providing thetraditional learning, based on the U.G.C standard, to the students of Vyakarana, Jyotisa,Sahitya, Dharmasastra, Nyaya, Vedanta, Mimamsa, Puranetihasa, Jaina Philosophy andBauddha Philosophy in the courses of Prakshastri (+2), Shastri (B.A), Acharya (M.A), andVidyavaridhi (Ph.D). In addition, the courses of Shikshashastri (B.Ed.) and Shiksha Acharya(M.Ed.) are being provided. This Non-Formal Sanskrit Education Centres are additional tothose formal courses in order to facilitate Sanskrit learning to the common people.

Eligibility for Enrolment: Any person desirous of Sanskrit Learning is eligible for the courses.

<u>Nature & Duration of the Course</u>: It is Part Time. And the course has a period of 11 months (September2022 to May 2023) tentatively 110 hours.

Study Material: Reading material will be provided by Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi.

<u>Examination</u>: The examination will be conducted by Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi at the end of the course and the certificates will be given to the successful students.

Attendance: minimum 80% attendance is needed for seating in the final examination.

<u>Enrolment Fee</u>: Students have to submit their application form in the Centre along with Rs.500/- (Five Hundred Rupees Only) as Enrolment fee for the Course. The authorized officer will send the collected fee through NEFT to the Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi.

Venue: Ambedkar College.

<u>Timings</u>: 3.30 PM to 5.30 PM (the days/timings may be subject to change, as per the convenience of the learners/teachers).

<u>Number of Students</u>: Ideal number of students in each batch may be 50. More than one batch may be considered.
