



NATIONAL WEBINAR ON "VALUES AND VIRTUES FOR PRESENT TIMES: REFLECTION THROUGH THE MAHABHARATA"

The department of History in collaboration with IQAC has organized National Webinar on "Values and Virtues for present Times: Reflection through the Mahabharata" on 2nd August 2021. The program was inaugurated by Professor Kiran Choudhury, Regional Director, IGNOU, Regional Centre, Agartala. Welcome address was given by the organizing Secretary Smt. L. Sailo. The webinar was attended by 62 participants. The two resource persons are Dr. Ravi Khangai, Assistant Professor, Post Graduate Teaching, Dept. of History, Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, and Dr. Geetesh Nirban, Assistant Professor (Senior Scale) In-charge Dept. of Philosophy Kamala Nehru College, University of Delhi.

Dr. Geetesh Nirban whose interests include ethics, Indian Philosophy, environmental philosophy, Mahābhārata, mindfulness and feminism discussed Peace as Inherent Value: Ethical Reflection through Mahabharata. She talks about Mahabharata as a peaceful value and the importance of Mahabharata in our daily life today. She also mentions about Mahabharata relation with peaceful life and the life that mankind has to live with.

Dr. Ravi Khangai discussed how the Mahabharata can address the modern day's concern, relationship between language and history, how it says about protection of environment-forest, trees and other non-human animals. He also addressed important questions like

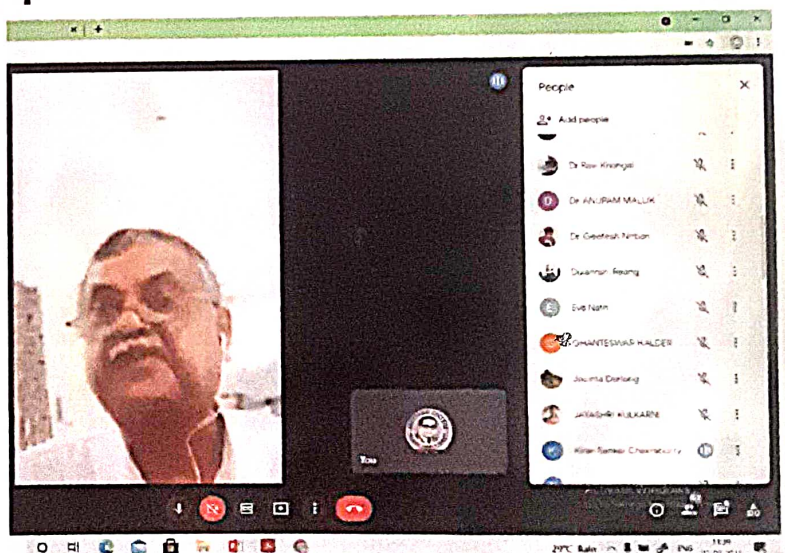
